Warrant Walk-In Procedure Standing Order
(Misdemeanor and Gross Misdemeanor Warrants Only)

Becker County District Court has created a one-time process for certain eligible case types to allow an individual to walk into the courthouse to address their warrant without being arrested.

Therefore, the following process is approved, adopted, and Ordered:

1. If you have a warrant on a misdemeanor or gross misdemeanor offense (except those case types noted below*):
 - **One Time, Monday-Friday no later than 4:00 pm**, you can walk into the Becker County Courthouse to Court Administration; **you will:**
 - update your contact information, and
 - sign for a new court date;
 - your previous release conditions will be reinstated (you will get a copy).

* *This Order does not apply to:*

- Driving While Impaired
- Order for Protection Violations
- Harassment Restraining Order Violations
- 5th Degree Assault
- Domestic Assault
- Interference with Privacy
- Indecent Exposure
- Domestic Abuse No Contact Order Violations

2. If bail or bond was forfeited, it will be reinstated.
