Proper Placement of Cart




3 feet distance between cart and any object

Directions for Cart Use:

-  Bin curbside, opening should face the street (handle side toward house)
-  Bin must be 3 feet from any object
-  Clean and empty containers only
-  Bin set out time- same as trash
-  Bring glass to public 'big blue bin' locations



-  NO Needles/sharps
-  NO Food Waste
-  NO Garbage
-  NO Styrofoam
-  NO Plastic bags
-  NO Scrap metal
