





















PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING TIPS:

- 1) Respect private and public property. Stay on the trail as wandering off may result in **CLOSING** of the trail
- 2) Do not disturb wildlife, livestock or damage crops, trees or shrubs
- 3) Deposit trash in trash receptacles
- 4) Be careful when crossing roadways; obey
- 5) Motorized vehicles are prohibited on trails
- 6) Travel at your own risk if crossing lakes or waterways
- 7) Alcohol and snowmobiling do not mix
- 8) Dress sensibly in layers and wear proper gear
- 9) Keep your machine well-maintained
- 10) A state trail sticker is required for all snowmobiles operating on state or grantin-aid trails. Stickers are available at electronic license system agents, including these advertisers: Richwood Store, Pinehurst Resort, and Wolf Lake Co-op Sampo.
