Tips to Trail Users

Welcome to the Winter Wonderland Snowmobile Trail, ski trails and outdoor recreation facilities. These trails are available for your use through the generosity of many property owners, donated time and effort by snowmobile clubs and the Department of Natural Resources.

PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING TIPS:

- 1) Respect private and public property. Stay on the trail as wandering off may result in CLOSING of the trail.
- 2) Do not disturb wildlife, livestock or damage crops, trees or shrubs.
- 3) Deposit trash in trash receptacles.
- 4) Be careful when crossing roadways; obey traffic laws.
- 5) Motorized vehicles are prohibited on trails.
- 6) Travel at your own risk if crossing lakes or waterways.
- 7) Alcohol and snowmobiling do not mix.
- 8) Dress sensibly in layers and wear proper gear.
- 9) Keep your machine well-maintained.
- 10) A state trail sticker is required for all snowmobiles operating on state or grant-in-aid trails. Stickers are available at electronic license system agents, including these advertisers: Pinehurst Resort, Rainbow Resort and Wolf Lake Co-op Sampo.

City of Detroit Lakes Snowmobile Ordinance

803.01 Definitions

1. Snowmobile "Snowmobile" means a self-propelled vehicle for travel on snow or ice or a natural terrain steered by wrist runners.
2. Operate "Operate" means to control the operation of a snowmobile.
3. Operator "Operator" means a person who operates or controls a snowmobile.

803.02 Restrictions

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a snowmobile under the following circumstances:

1. On private property of another without the express permission of the owner or occupant of said property.
2. On public school grounds, park property, playgrounds, and areas and skating rinks when prohibited by the proper public authority.
3. In a manner so as to create loud, unnecessary or unusual noise that may interfere with the peace and quiet of other persons.
4. In a careless, reckless, or negligent manner so as to endanger any person or the property of any other person.
5. Without having such snowmobile registered as provided in the Statutes §4.61 through §4.68.
6. If for more than 90 days but less than 180 days after the expiration of having in his possession a valid snowmobile safety certificate pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes §4.66
7. While under the influence of intoxicating beverages or narcotic forming drugs.
8. Without a lighted head and tail light when required for safety.

9. If under the age of fourteen years, on public property, including, but not limited to, streets, alleys, and highway within the city.

803.03 Use in Parks

Notwithstanding the prohibitions of this section, the park board of the city shall have authority to supervise and regulate events or programs in which snowmobiles are used. The park board shall have the authority to designate city parks, playgrounds, recreational and skating rink areas that they shall deem available for the use of snowmobiles.

803.04 Equipment

All snowmobiles operated within the city shall have the following equipment:

1. Mufflers which are properly attached and which reduce the noise of operation of the vehicle to a minimum, and no person shall use a muffler cutoff, bypass, or similar device on said vehicles.
2. Adequate brakes, head and tail lamps and reflective material as prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 84, and regulations promulgated thereto.
3. A safety or so-called "dead man" throttle in operating condition: a safety or "dead man" throttle is defined as a device which, when pressure is removed from the accelerator or throttle causes the motor to be disengaged from the driving track.

803.05 Parking

Subdivision 1. Manner. No owner or operator shall leave or allow a snowmobile to be or remain on public property when the motor is running or when the key is in the ignition switch.

Subdivision 2. Location. No person shall park a snowmobile on a boulevard, street, alley or highway within the city.

803.06 Sidewalks

No person shall operate a snowmobile on a sidewalk or boulevard except to make a right angle crossing.
