The Minnesota Counties Insurance Trust regarding Workmen's Compensation for the RRVCSA Board members was discussed.

Motion by Carol Schoff, second by Julian Sjostrom that the RRVCSA not consider the recommendation that MCIT is proposing on Workmen's Compensation for RRVCSA members. They indicated that each Board Member is appointed from their local Soil and Water Conservation Board and not the Joint Powers Board. RRVCSA members are also compensated from their local Soil and Water Conservation District. They felt each RRVCSA board member should be covered by their local Soil and Water Conservation District. Affirmative: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Status of organizational changes with the Secretary of State and Federal IRS was discussed. All documentation from the IRS has been received and the name has been changed. The Host District has not received from the following districts their copy from the Secretary of State with stamp and number. Kittson, West Polk, Roseau, Red Lake.

The Annual Agreement for reimbursement for cell phone, land phone and the internet with Engineering Technician Jeff Haverland was presented for approval for the amount of \$118.00 per month.

Engineer Jim Hest would prefer to have just one cell phone.

Motion by Lyle Dittman, seconded by Linda Mickelson to approve the Annual Agreement for reimbursement for the cell phone, land phone and the internet with Jeff Haverland as presented and that the Administrator make a decision on the cell phone for the engineer. Affirmative: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by John Gaukerud, seconded by Julian Sjostrom to approve the purchase of the computer for the RRVCSA Engineering Technician. Affirmative: Unanimous. Motion carried.

AutoCAD subscription was discussed and it is now cheaper to subscribe to annual upgrades than to purchase outright over a 3 year period. The engineer and the engineering technician both will need a seat and be upgraded for the subscription

Motion by Wallace Byklum, seconded by Carol Schoff to approve the annual subscription for the AutoCAD subscription for both the engineer and the engineering technician. Affirmative: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on large, time consuming engineering projects. Examples are: Wildrice Watershed District 400 acre wetland, Becker Dam, stream back projects in Red Lake, WRP project in West Otter Tail County, JPB contracting with BWSR. These requests would have to come from the Districts.

The Board felt this could be accomplished with the current RRVCSA Engineering Assistance Fee Schedule to the Soil and Water Conservation District. The Board felt it could be accomplished with the Note on the bottom of the Fee Schedule, which states: Higher fees may be charged for unusually large or complex projects, based upon a determination by the engineering staff after the initial site investigation.

Engineering Technician Jeff Haverland and Engineer Jim Hest reviewed their November reports.

Next meeting date will be Wednesday, March 3rd, 2010 in Mahnomen.

It was noted that the RRVCSA does not have to have a website at this time.
