Blue Grama: Bouteloua gracillis





Plant Structure: This is a native perennial grass that leaves are 4 inches high with seedheads 1-2 feet. Only 12-14 in. in full flower, this is among the shortest of the native ornamental grasses. It is fine-leaved and produces blue-green seedheads which are suspended horizontally like tiny brushes from the tip of each stem. The plant turns tan when dormant. Blue grama grows in bunches in the south, and as a sod-former in the north and at high elevations. It is a perennial.
