

Plant Characteristics: A large vigorous narrow crowned, male tree. Upright in overall growth. The most common parent species of these hybrids are Cottonwood (*Populus deltoides*) and Black Poplar (Populus nigra). These hybrids are referred to as the *P.* x *euramericana* hybrids.

Size: Height: 40-60'

Width: 20-35'

Foliage: Leaf is 2–5" long and 2–5" wide. The leaf is green to dark green with a yellow fall color.

Flower: Male

Fruit:: None

Soil: Clay loams to sandy loams.

USDA Hardiness Zone: Zone 3

Light Range: Full sun 💥

pH Range: 5.5—7.5 pH

- Other: Will not tolerate drought on upland sites -High water table required on coarse-textured soils
 - Young trees are used for food by deer, rabbits, mice and beaver
 - used in windbreaks, visual screens and provide quick tree cover
