

- <u>Plant Characteristics</u>: Heavily branched crown in youth and in old age the crown is somewhat symmetrically oval with the characteristic tufted foliage. Crown is sparse and oval.
- <u>Size:</u> Height: 50-80'

Width: variable

- Foliage: Medium to dark color green. Brittle, sharp pointed needles in two's, persisting for 4 years. Needles are 5-6" long and snap when bent.
- Flower: Monecious, no ornamental value
- **Fruit**:: Light brown cone that is 2" long and 1–2 inches wide.
- Soil: Prefers dry, loose, sandy soil with low pH

- <u>Tolerances</u>: Extremely cold tolerant Tolerates alkaline soil.
- USDA Hardiness Zone: Zone 2–5
- <u>Light Range:</u> Full sun. ``
- pH Range: 6.8 or less.
- Other: -extremely resistant to insects and disease
 - medium rate of growth, about 6"/year
 - susceptible to salt damage
 - Attracts songbirds upland game birds
 - Mammals
 - used for groves and windbreaks
