

- <u>Plant Characteristics</u>: This is a semi-weeping, spreading tree.
- <u>Size</u>: Height: 20 ft. to 30 ft.
  - Width: 10 ft. to 30 ft.
- **Foliage**: dark reddish green foliage turning reddish purple in fall.
- Flower: Long lasting, showy, single
  - Rose-red buds produce pale pink to rose pink blooms, 1 4/5" diameter.
- **Fruit**:: Bright red , 1/2" in diameter, persistent into the winter.
- <u>Soil:</u> Heavy loams, highly adaptable. Welldrained, moist and acid.

- Tolerances: Moderately drought tolerant
- USDA Hardiness Zone; Zone 3
- Light Range: Full Sun 💛
- <u>pH:</u> 5.0—6.5 pH
- <u>Other:</u>
  - require little pruning which should be completed before early June
  - initiate flower buds for the next season in mid-June to early July and pruning at this time or later would result in decreased flower
    - production for next year
  - used for windbreaks and wildlife cover
