The purpose of the meeting was to hear a presentation and request for a resolution on the Bad Medicine Lake Diagnostic Study proposal.

Steve Lindow of Bad Medicine Lake Association arrived. Steve explained the purpose of the study and the grant being applied for through the Department of Natural Resources. The grant will be a three year grant for \$121,826, and require a 1:1 match, which can be in-kind. The grant application is due tomorrow, March 8th.

In order to submit the grant, the Lake Association needs a resolution from the SWCD authorizing the SWCD to submit the grant for the project and a Conflict of Interest Disclosure statement. The Becker SWCD did approve serving as the LGU for this project in October of 2012.
