5. X-c Skiing – Lin Peterson, guest

7. Regional Park (by Frazee) Update
 - Developing GMRPTC designation application
 - Final Resolution Form (not filled in): In applying for GMRPTC consideration as a joint applicant, there is a need to provide a separate resolution of support utilizing the GMRPTC form as a guide for each joint applicant (Frazee and Becker County). This becomes important because within the resolution (see attachment) there is a need to identify who is the lead applicant?

10. Pine Grove Update: MNDOT Limited Use Permit (LUP)
 - Permit Requirement: Price for Handicap Unit and tray for Pine Grove site would be \$2280.00/year. Current cost for regular satellite at Pine Grove is \$1,845.00. A dif. of +435.00/yr.
 - Also need to put in ADA accessible gravel pathway (STS crew; minimal cost).

11. Eagle Lake Park – FYI

- Subsequent NRM position was not to purchase property, but if the City property were conveyed to the County for \$1 then would consider/explore managing property. Status: City seeking to determine property value and have internal discussions about next steps.

- Army COE Permit: COE to allow DNR to discuss 106 review with SHPO. Permit required to get the ball rolling on the project - ideally this fall.
- Boit contract under review from Co. Attorney's office – should hear from them shortly.
