- 1. Call Meeting to Order: Hank Ludtke called the Regular meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.
- 2. Approval of Board Agenda. Motion by Knutson, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Vareberg, motion carried.
- **3.** Approval of January Meeting Minutes: Motion to approve with corrections by Vareberg 2<sup>nd</sup> by Knutson, motion carried.
- **4.** Balance Sheets/Paying of Bills: Motion to approve Paying Bills and Balance Sheet/Financials by Mulari 2<sup>nd</sup> by Anderson, motion carried;
- From Check Register/Invoices Presented: Workshop \$1,477.54, Hwy 34 Group Home \$150.00, Low Income Public Housing \$36,962.79; Willow Property \$2,050.28; Maple Ave. Apts. \$5,471.24, Hidden Hills Group Home \$225.00, West River Townhomes \$13,504.57 and Section 8 Voucher \$21,374.00.

- 5. Housing/Economic Development Update
- **PH Inquire about Grant Funds:** Need to look at PH improvements; attend webinar to determine what is entailed in applying for grant assistance. \$800,000 requested in 2003.
- Workshop: Look at options is there a need for the workshop building; asset not being used. Potential tenant was looking at it had had a fire inspector visit the structure, was looking at some modification, but the pandemic interrupted that process/interest. Do summary of space/put on market. Laura will explore further.
- MURL one owner having difficulty making payments (Lake Park); discuss options about tenant and house; \$71,000 balance owed. Compliance period no longer in effect. Currently \$144.mo. payment. Renew contract and clean up credit? 2<sup>nd</sup> Audubon home closing in March. Two contracts due in 2021.
- HOMe Program discussion about where money had come from to fund first \$10,000 to the HOMe program came from Small Cities grant reallocation (\$7,200) and from EDA administration (\$2,800). review of funders and loans to-date; interest by Board in looking at providing a second round of funding. Motion to approve \$10,000 in funding towards the HOMe Program by Felker, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Knutson, motion carried.
- CARES Update: Status Update of Grant programs: 2k R1, 2K-R2, Block Grant, CARE Grant and 1K Childcare provder grant was added.
