- 1. Call Meeting to Order: Hank Ludtke called the Regular meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

- 3. Approval of August Meeting Minutes: Motion to approve by Felker, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Anderson, motion carried.
- Check Registers/Paying Bills/Financials: Motion to approve August Bills by Anderson, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Sean, motion carried.   - **MURL:** Property on Hwy 21 cancellation of Contract for Deed October 12, 2021, 107 Maple Avenue, Frazee, MN foundation work; one quote received; <u>Motion to get 2<sup>nd</sup> quote by Mulari, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Felker.</u>
  - WRT: Mahube case management making in person visits again at WRT. 1 eviction; checking on family composition on 3 other units.

  - <u>New Provider Start up Assistance</u>. Up to \$10,000 grant per new start up; and

- <u>Child Care Provider Emergency Grants</u>: Funds calculated on a per child basis; per # of FTE and PTE kids; estimate of \$85,000 in 2021 and \$85,000 in 2022.
