- 1. Call Meeting to Order: Ludtke called the Regular meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.
- 2. <u>Approval of Board Agenda as amended with addition to Public Housing Motion by Klyve, 2nd by Felker, motion carried.</u>
- 3. <u>Approval of September 2022 Meeting Minutes</u>: Corrections to September minutes made. <u>Motion to approve</u> with corrections by Klyve, 2nd by Knutson. motion carried.
- 4. Consent Items: Check Registers/Paying Bills/Financials:
 - Discussion about insurance payment. State Farm is the insurer, and the houses are insured at replacement value, not fair market value.
 - Motion to approve September bills and accept financials by Anderson, 2nd by Felker motion carried.
- 5. Housing Update (Laura McKnight)
 - Public Housing: Public Hearing -
 - Public housing is currently full.
 - MURL- update by MMCDC staff.
 - Sprouls -Currently behind in her payments. Has applied for the home help program. There are
 concerns with moving her into another property however, MMCDC does not want to set her up to
 fail. Waiting on tribe money and the home help program. Another option is for the EDA to buy
 her out, but an appraisal would need to be done.
 - Skramstad House located on County Hwy 21. the house has been secured and the cleanup should be competed in the next week. After discussion it was decided to sell the property "as is".
 Motion by Knutson, 2nd by Klyve. Motion carried.
 - Motion by Klyve to request the County Attorney to send a letter to the Minnesota Attorney
 General's Office in regard to using the MURL fund balance that is available for additional housing investments. 2nd by Felker. Motion carried.
 - PHA 5 Year Action Plan Review
 - No policies updated; a public notice is set for November. No motions are needed at this meeting.
 - Motion by Felker, 2nd by Anderson to accept the Housing update. Motion carried.
 - Fair Market Rents-The Fair Market Rents (FMR) are set by HUD based on the market rents in the area. The Payment Standards used to determine the amount of subsidy for the Voucher holder will be increased to

reflect the increased FMR for the area. <u>Motion to approve the increase of the Payment Standards by</u> Klyve, 2nd by Felker. Motion carried.

6. Economic Development

- Childcare Update-Presented by Tammy Anderson, Eric Rotter, and Kelsey Varty from the Becker County ECDF Advisory Committee. No action is needed at this time as this was an informational presentation/discussion. Focus has been on recruiting but now the focus is switching to retaining the childcare already in place. Motion by Klyve to support the Becker County ECDF Advisory Committee, 2nd by Felker.
- Monthly Reports-Hendrickson reports the nonrestricted 2022 EDA budget accounts will be
 approximately \$2000 off due to investment interest is being placed in the 2022 housing
 accounts instead of the EDA accounts. Motion by Felker, 2nd by Anderson. Motion carried.
- **Drake Property**-(Skoog)- the deed restriction has been removed.
- Wannigan Park Project-(Ludke)-Negotiations are happening now-more updates in December. Presentations and projects have been very supportive by the community. Projects are continuing at this time.
- Review of ARPA updates-(Oman)-Major project of scanning official documents starting with the County Recorder's and the Planning and Zoning Offices. Human Services is a separate project due to privacy concerns. Progress is being made on all projects.
- Motion to accept the Economic Development updates by Anderson. 2nd by Felker. Motion carried.
- Update on EDA Director-Sending back to band and grade, retitling the position to the EDA Specialist. If approved, then to finance committee and the board.

7. Open Forum

- (Anderson) -Updates on major housing projects going on in Lake Park. A 32-unit apartment building, 2 8-plexes, some single-family homes, high school being torn down, 3 6-plexes, and 6 2level townhouses.
