VA processes one million disability claims faster than ever before

The Department of Veterans Affairs announced on February 25, 2025 that it has processed more than a million disability claims in Fiscal Year 2025, reaching the milestone nearly two weeks faster than it did in FY24. Despite receiving 15.6% more claims than last year, the department completed its one millionth FY25 claim Feb. 20 – faster than at any point in the department's history. In fact, the 10 highest claims processing days in VA's history occurred within the last month, and the department's highest claims processing day ever was Feb. 12, when VA processed more than 12,000 claims.

Through January, VA has provided \$62 billion in compensation and pension benefit payments to 6.9 million Veterans and survivors. VA's claims accuracy rate has risen to more than 92%. To date, VA has completed 375,961 PACT Act related claims in FY25.

PACT Act – 2024 Expanded Health Care Eligibility

Beginning March 5, 2024, VA made all Veterans who meet the basic service and discharge requirements and were exposed to toxins while serving our country eligible to enroll directly in VA health care without first applying for VA benefits.

This expansion of care means that all Veterans who served in the Vietnam War, the Gulf War, Iraq, Afghanistan, the Global War on Terror or any other combat zone after 9/11 will be eligible to enroll directly in VA health care without first applying for VA benefits. Additionally, Veterans who never deployed but were exposed to toxins or hazards while training or on active duty in the United States will also be eligible to enroll.

Beware: Claim Predators Want to Prey on Your Benefits

Many Veterans seek support and help with filing VA benefits claims for the payments they deserve. Be cautious of "claim predators" - unaccredited companies or individuals targeting Veterans' benefits for profit. *How to identify claim predators:*

<u>Charging High Fees:</u> Predatory companies charge absurd fees or require you to pay a portion of your VA benefits. Never pay anyone a fee to file an initial claim for benefits.

<u>Making Dishonest Promises:</u> Don't trust anyone who claims they can help accelerate the claims process and obtain a 100% disability benefits evaluation. Remember, only VA has the authority to determine disability ratings.

Requiring Binding Contracts: No one should ever charge a fee to file an initial claim for VA benefits. Never sign a contract agreeing to pay an unauthorized individual/company a percentage of your benefit payment in exchange for help with your VA claim.
